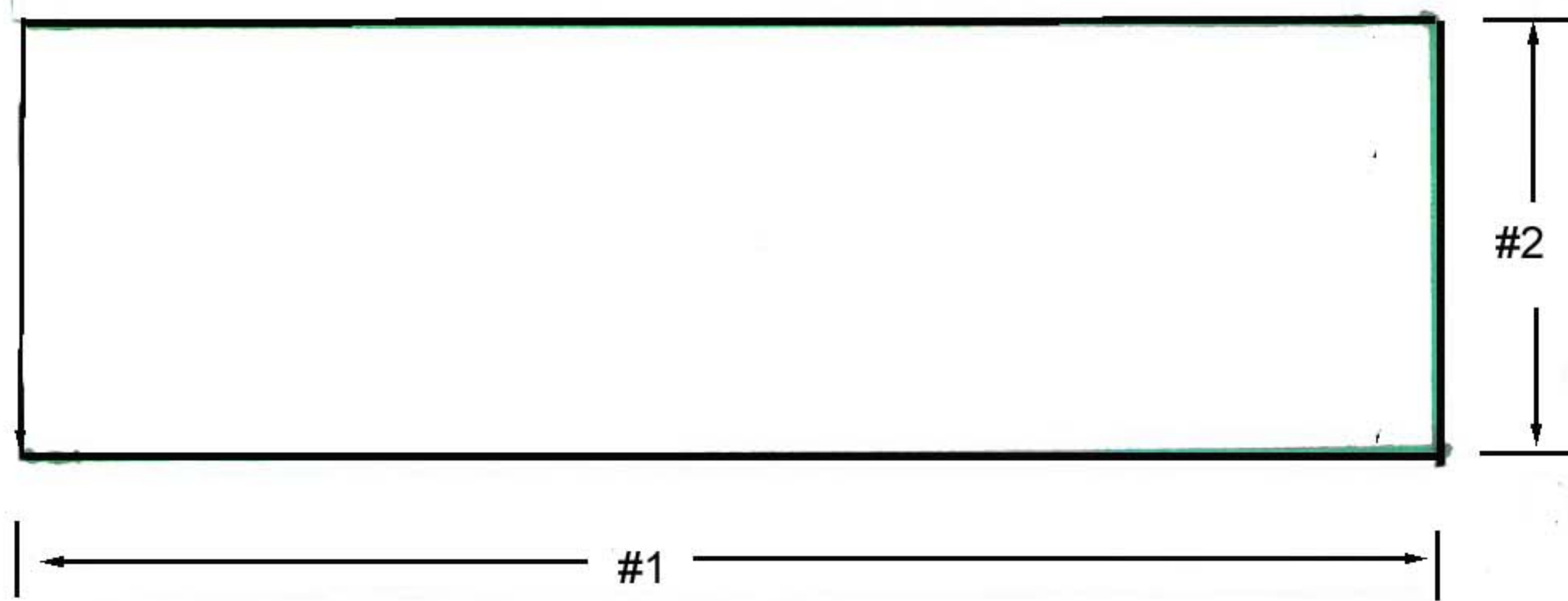


## Measuring Guide for a Rectangular Island



### Information needed for a quote:

(countertop measurements only)

- 1)
- 2)
- 3) Island Height (ground to counter top)?
- 4) Does the island have a umbrella hole?      Do you want an umbrella hole in the cover?
- 5) Does the island have any rounded ends or corners?
- 6) Cover Fabric (circle one): Polyester or Sunbrella
- 7) Cover style (circle one): Mini Skirt (hangs 12") or Full Length

### Additional information needed for ordering a form fitting Island cover:

- 8) If yes to question 4, where is the umbrella hole located (mark with and X on the island above.
- 9) (From the cooking side ) What's the measurement from the (right / left ) edge of counter to the center of the hole?      What is the measurement from the back of the island to the center of the hole?

### Grill Measurements:

- 10) Grill hood width?
- 11) Grill depth (front of grill to the back)?
- 12) Grill Height (from the main counter to it's highest point)?
- 13) Grill Make?      Model ( or # of burners)?
- 14) What is the measurment from the Right side of the main counter to the right side of the grill?  
**Remeber number 10, 14, & 15 must equal the answer for question #2**
- 15) Left side of main counter to the left side of the grill?
- 16) How far does the front of your grill stick out past the island?

### Faucet (sink) Measurements:

- 17) Where is the sink located? (circle one): Right side or Left side
- 18) Sink Position: parallel to the counter or at a 45 degree?
- 19) What is the measurement from the right side edge of the main counter to the faucet's handle?
- 20) What is the measurement from the cooking side of the counter to the faucet's spout?
- 21) What is the faucet's width?      length (back of faucet to front of spout)?
- 22) What is the height of the faucet (from the coutertop)?
